Application Requirements (Inside Program)

1. An application fee of \$30 is due, and payable at the time of application
2. Applicant must be a high school graduate or have a G.E.D. and be at least 17 years of age at the time of application.
3. Applicant must have completed one full year of high school algebra with a passing grade, or its equivalent with a passing grade, or one semester of post high school algebra with a passing grade; or the electrical training ALLIANCE online Tech Math Course. ([NJATC Tech Math Course](#))
4. To qualify to take the aptitude test, applicants must have the following documents turned into the J.A.T.C. office within **30 days** of applying:
 - OFFICIAL/SEALED high school transcripts – **submit in sealed envelope** from the school.
 - G.E.D. (**OFFICIAL/SEALED transcripts** from the issuing facility.
 - Proof of age.
 - Copy of valid driver's license for the state in which the applicant resides.
 - Copies of any other educational certificates (college, trade school, etc.) If the algebra requirement was achieved by a post high school course, an official/sealed transcript is required.
 - Applicants are encouraged, but not required, to submit a resume and up to three(3) reference letters. Submitted any time, up to and including, their aptitude test date.
5. A military veteran who completed military technical training school in a Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) applicable to the electrical construction trade (as determined by the J.A.T.C.), and can document a minimum of two (2) years of military experience in that MOS, will qualify for an oral interview by the J.A.T.C. to be considered along with other qualified applicants.
6. All qualified applicants will be required to take the NJATC Aptitude Test Battery (Sanctioned by the U.S. Dept. of Labor). Applicants are required to receive a minimum score of "5" or higher to be eligible for an interview.
7. Minimum age of indenture is 18 years of age.
8. Applicants selected for apprenticeship will be required to provide results of a physical exam. (At the expense of the JATC).
9. All applicants selected for the apprenticeship program will be required to submit to a urinalysis test for substance abuse as a condition of initial and ongoing indentureship. (At the J.A.T.C.'s expense).
10. All applicants selected from the pool of interviewed applicants will be required to pass a background check.
11. All applicants accepted and indentured must sign a Scholarship Loan Agreement (SLA).
12. Applicants will be accepted without discrimination because of race, religion, national origin, age, or sex.

Inside Apprenticeship Program Participation

The geographic jurisdiction, by county, of this JATC is as follows:

In the state of Indiana, the counties of:

Brown, Clay, Greene, Knox, Monroe, Owen, Parke, Sullivan and Vigo.

In the state of Illinois, the counties of:

Clark, Crawford, Edgar, Jasper, Lawrence and Richland.

As an apprentice in this apprenticeship and training program, periodic advances are presently awarded according to the following schedule:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Percentage of Journeyman Rate</u>	<u>Minimum OJT Hours</u>	<u>Related Training Completed</u>
1st	45%	0-1000	Satisfactory Progress
2nd	50%	1000-2000	1st Year School
3rd	55%	2000-3500	2nd Year School
4th	60%	3500-5000	3rd Year School
5th	70%	5000-6500	4th Year School
6th	85%	6500-8000	5th Year School

***Current Journeyman Rate: **\$40.00** as of 10/01/2022

[Example: To advance to third period, one must have satisfactorily completed the first year of related training and must also have accumulated 2000 hours of OJT with satisfactory performance.]

To be advanced, the apprentice must have satisfactorily completed both requirements: OJT hours and Related Training. Successful completion of one year of related training and the minimum OJT hours are required for advancement - except for advancement to the second period, during the probationary period. In this case, a minimum of 1000 OJT hours and satisfactory progress in related training are required.
